Circuit / Paddock / Pit garage Set up:

Thursday 10 June 1:00pm to 8:00pm

No set up on Friday

Outside these hours, from Wednesday afternoon at 5:00 pm, competitors will be directed to a parking area outside the circuit (red zone with electricity). Competitors will have to leave the paddock and the pit garages at the latest on Sunday 13/06 at 9:00pm, those who wish to stay on Sunday evening will be able to park on a parking lot with water and electricity.

Spectator access from Friday 11 June

You will not be able to collect trailers and trucks before 6:30pm on Sunday. **Race cars must remain visible to spectators** throughout the event. Pit garages will have to stay open every day from 12:00 to 1:25pm.

Circuit Access / Pass Collection:

All participants, Drivers, Teams, Guests, Media must be accredited and go to the <u>Welcome Centre</u> located at the main entrance of the Circuit before being able to access the site (in application of a strict health protocol). <mark>Vouchers must be</mark> obtained online before 3rd June <u>ON THIS LINK</u> (ask your grid manager for the password), it must include the 7-day quarantine and curfew exemption letters. Then, competitors will be able to get their passes when signing in.

Welcome Centre opening hours:

Thursday: 1:00pm-8:00pm - Friday, Saturday, Sunday: 7:30am-5:00pm

HEALTH PROTOCOL: <u>HERE</u>

PCR test taken less than 72 h ago required, temperature test.

All participants, including those who have been vaccinated, will need to show a PCR test from less than 72h ago or a valid health pass to get on to the Circuit. A check point will be set up at the "Welcome Centre" when you show your accreditation. For people from abroad only if you forget: An antigenic self-test cell will be provided under the control of a professional (limited quantity, 60€ cash only).

To facilitate your return travel, you can register to get a PCR test on the Circuit during the event: <u>(tutorial)</u> \rightarrow <u>WITH THIS LINK</u>

The health measures will be updated and detailed after any changes and new government decisions, on the website <u>www.hvmracing.fr.</u>.

Paddock:

<u>Grids 3-6-11</u> Each competitor/car definitively entered and confirmed by the grid operator at the latest on 15 May 2021 will have a spot under a tent in the paddock. Tent: 5x5m, Electricity 1 16A outlet

<u>Grids 5-7-8-10-12</u> Each competitor/car entered will be placed in a dedicated area in the paddock.

Grids 1-2-4-9 Each competitor / car entered will be in the pit garages.

The vans, small trucks, tractors, camping-cars and other vehicles are not authorised in the paddock. They will have specific parking available. Passenger cars are not authorised in the paddock and should be parked in the competitor parking lots from Thursday.

Pit garages : Grids 1-2-4-9: The keys can be collected in the Pit Building's Reception Hall, Thursday from 1pm to 8pm. 50€ deposit in cash or credit card. *The competitors must leave the pit garages open during the pitwalk* (see official schedule of the event).

Competitors welcome office: Located inside the Pit building in VIP room n°6, we will be delighted to receive you there throughout the event. You will be able to come and perform your administrative checks, collect your final passes, practice session tickets, participation tickets, access to hospitality etc... **Open hours**: Thursday, 10 June from 2:00 pm to 8:00 pm and Friday, Saturday, Sunday from 7:30 am to 7:00 pm.

Signing on will take place at the Competitors welcome office (except grids 5 and 6), on Thursday from 2:00pm to 8:00pm and on Friday from 7:30am until 90 minutes before the drivers briefing.

Scrutineering will take place in situ (Paddock or Pit garages) on Friday from 8:30am and until 90 minutes before the drivers briefing. Competitors must stay close to their car with safety driver's equipment during this day in order to be available to scrutineers. *FFSA Driver/Car Equipment sheet* only for French grids.

Drivers briefing sessions: Please refer to your grid's briefing times. They will take place in the Media Centre 2. You can access the location using the outside stairs.

Private practices: Sessions will be available on Friday. We recommend booking the practice session in advance to make sure you get a spot and the discount price. Bookings can be made online before Friday 4 June at 9:00am on www.hvmracing.fr in the Grand Prix de France Historique section, secured payment by credit card.

Licences: Drivers should have a National or International valid race licence.

For grids 1,2,4 and 9: FIA International Licence required.

For grids **3**, **5**, **6**, **7**, **8**, **10**, **11**, **12**: Foreign drivers holding a national license will have to present authorisation to participate abroad issued by their ASN unless a permanent authorisation is specified on the license. It is possible to get licenses for the weekend. To get one, you must show your driver's license or a photocopy. The 2021 prices are: TPNVHCC: 32€ ASA cost + 133€ for ASA Classic. It can be done on the competitors welcome office.

Pass: 4 pass / car, you can buy additional pass when you will process to your accreditation : <u>ON THIS LINK</u>, all the vouchers must be presented at the Welcome Centre at the entrance of the Circuit (<u>Opening hours</u>: Thursday 1:00pm-8:00pm Friday, Saturday, Sunday: 7:30-17:00). Competitors will be able to collect their passes when signing on.

Transponders: Only TAG Heuer by Chronelec transponders can be used during all the races. Transponders can be rented from timekeeping at the rate of 50 € per meeting, except for grid 11 (Deposit: 300€ cheque or cash). **The transponders with numbers from 1000 to 20000 no longer work.** You can buy transponders on the ITS Chrono website, by clicking on this link.

Track walk: Possible on foot only on Thursday 10 June from 5:00pm to 7:00pm.

Video broadcast: Want to see 100% of the circuit and the races live? Download the free VOGO SPORT application, connect to the VOGO SPORT WIFI network and follow the track races live; choose from several angles of view, go back to take another look at a manoeuvre or an overtake, zoom in and freeze frame! Download VOGO SPORT! Available on Apple store and Google Play, the VOGO SPORT application works in the paddocks and the "Public" area.

Competitors catering:

Food Truck on the paddock, open from Thursday to Sunday.
